Tuition & Fees

Tuition for the 2020-2021 academic year is \$22,350 for kindergarten – 8th grade. Fees for each grade vary to include the costs for textbooks, daily snacks, annual non-profit corporate membership, class activities, facilities, technology, and field trips. Additional fees for families are items such as uniforms (uniform exchange is available), extended day care, and after school enrichment classes.

Foothill offers a one payment, two payment, or 10-month payment plan for families through FACTS, an online payment management system. All families are required to create an online account with FACTS to process tuition and fees.

Financial Assistance

We understand that a Foothill education is a significant investment and are committed to helping make Foothill a viable option for students in our community.

At Foothill, the financial assistance application process is thoughtful, thorough, and confidential. The Admissions Committee reviews all applications for admission without regard to any financial need. However, new and returning Foothill families who seek financial assistance are required to submit an application every year.

Foothill Country Day School partners with **School and Student Services (SSS) by the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS)**. The Parent Financial Statement, located on the SSS website, must be completed by all families who seek financial assistance. The SSS system uses a variety of factors to determine a family's projected contribution toward tuition costs. Foothill, in turn, uses the information from that site, along with a family's most recent tax returns as verification, to create a potential financial aid package.

In order for your financial aid application to be complete, we require the following:

- 1) Complete the Parent Financial Statement (PFS) with SSS by the priority deadline.
- 2) Additional Statement – please use this space on the SSS application to inform the Financial Assistance Committee about any extenuating circumstances not reflected in your PFS.
- 3) Upload a copy of your 2018 tax return(s) with your SSS application.
